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**Six (6) Strategies For Fathering Forward**

1. We must remain in our homes with our children and spouse.

a. The Word of God tells us what we are to do and how we are to do it.

EPHESIANS 5:25 (NKJV)

*Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her.*

b. How does Christ love the church?

PROVERBS 5:18 (NKJV)

*Let your fountain be blessed, and rejoice with the wife of your youth.*

c. God as Father never leaves nor forsakes.

2. Be a redemptive resource in your parental relationship.

ISAIAH 63:16 (NLT)

*Surely you are still our Father! Even if Abraham and Jacob would disown us, LORD, you would still be our Father. You are our Redeemer from ages past.*

a. Be willing to pay the price for the freedom and liberty of your children.

b. Be willing to forgive.

LUKE 15:17-24 (NLT) [The Prodigal Son]

*When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, ‘At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am dying of hunger!’<sup>18</sup> I will go home to my father and say, ‘Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you,<sup>19</sup> and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant.’”<sup>20</sup> “So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him.<sup>21</sup> His son said to him, ‘Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.’<sup>22</sup> “But his father said to the servants, ‘Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger and sandals for his feet.<sup>23</sup> And kill the calf we have been fattening. We must celebrate with a feast,<sup>24</sup> for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found.’ So the party began.*

3. Become skilled molders and developers of our children.

JEREMIAH 29:11 (NKJV)

*For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.*

ISAIAH 64:8 (NKJV)

*But now, O LORD, You are our Father; we are the clay, and You our potter; and all we are the work of Your hand.*

JEREMIAH 3:4 (NKJV)

*Will you not from this time cry to Me, ‘My Father, You are the guide of my youth?’*

DEUTERONOMY 6:4-9 (NKJV)

*Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! <sup>5</sup>You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. <sup>6</sup>“And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. <sup>7</sup>You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. <sup>8</sup>You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. <sup>9</sup>You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.*

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I CORINTHIANS 3:10 (NKJV)

*According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. But let each one take heed how he builds on it.*

PROVERBS 4:11 (NKJV)

*I have taught you in the way of wisdom; I have led you in right paths.*

4. Love your children unconditionally.

LUKE 15:20 (NKJV)

*And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.*

5. Train them to do in private what you want them to do in public.

JOSHUA 24:15 (NKJV)

*And if it seems evil to you to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.*

II TIMOTHY 1:5 (NKJV)

*when I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.*

6. The parental tool kit.

- a. Teaching in real time.

DEUTERONOMY 6:7 (NKJV)

*You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.*

- b. Training in real time.

PROVERBS 22:6 (NKJV)

*Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it.*

ISAIAH 38:19 (NKJV)

*The living, the living man, he shall praise You, as I do this day; the father shall make known Your truth to the children.*

- c. Provision in real time.

II CORINTHIANS 12:14 (NKJV)

*Now for the third time I am ready to come to you. And I will not be burdensome to you; for I do not seek yours, but you. For the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children.*

- d. Nurturing in real time.

EPHESIANS 6:4 (NKJV)

*And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the [nurture] and admonition of the Lord.*

COLOSSIANS 3:21 (NKJV)

*Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.*

e. Discipline in real time.

I TIMOTHY 3:4 (NKJV)

*One who rules his own house well, having his children in submission with all reverence.*

PROVERBS 3:11-12 (NKJV)

*My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, nor detest His correction; <sup>12</sup> For whom the LORD loves He corrects, just as a father the son in whom he delights.*

I SAMUEL 2:29 (NKJV)

*Why do you kick at My sacrifice and My offering which I have commanded in My dwelling place, and honor your sons more than Me, to make yourselves fat with the best of all the offerings of Israel My people?*

HEBREWS 12:5-11 (NKJV)

*And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: “My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him; <sup>6</sup> For whom the LORD loves He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives.” <sup>7</sup> If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? <sup>8</sup> But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons. <sup>9</sup> Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? <sup>10</sup> For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness. <sup>11</sup> Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.*
